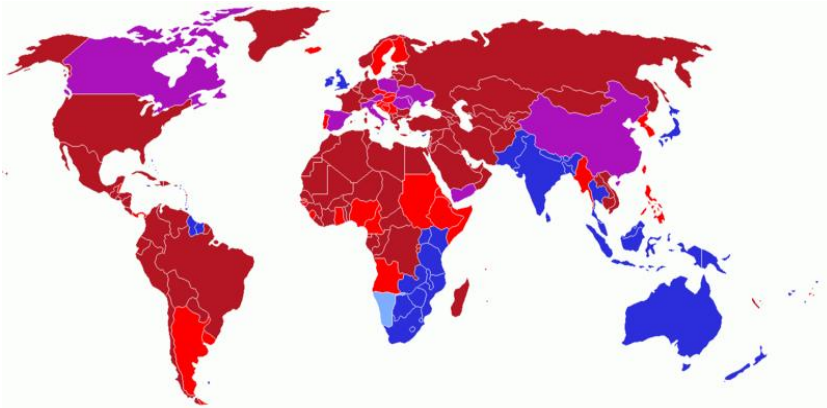

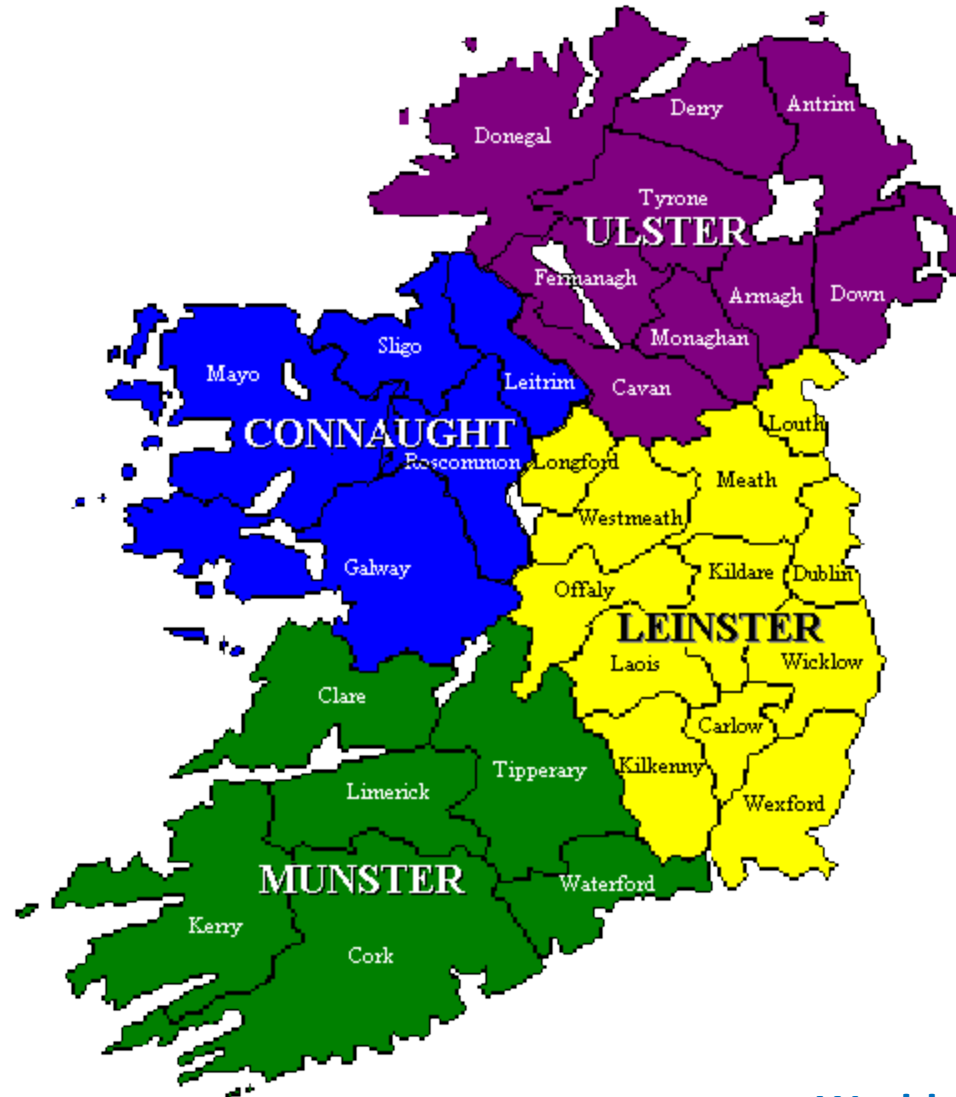

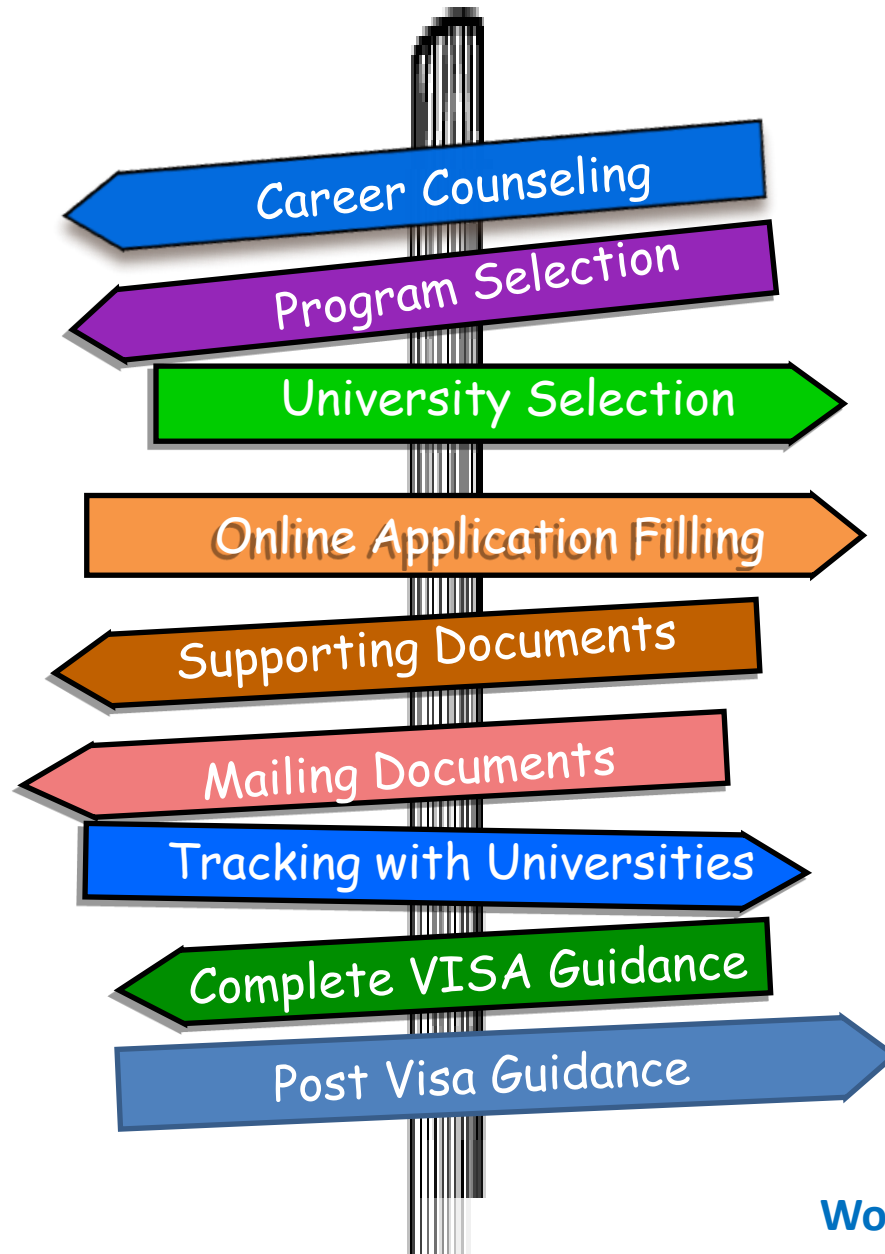


# Higher Education in IRELAND

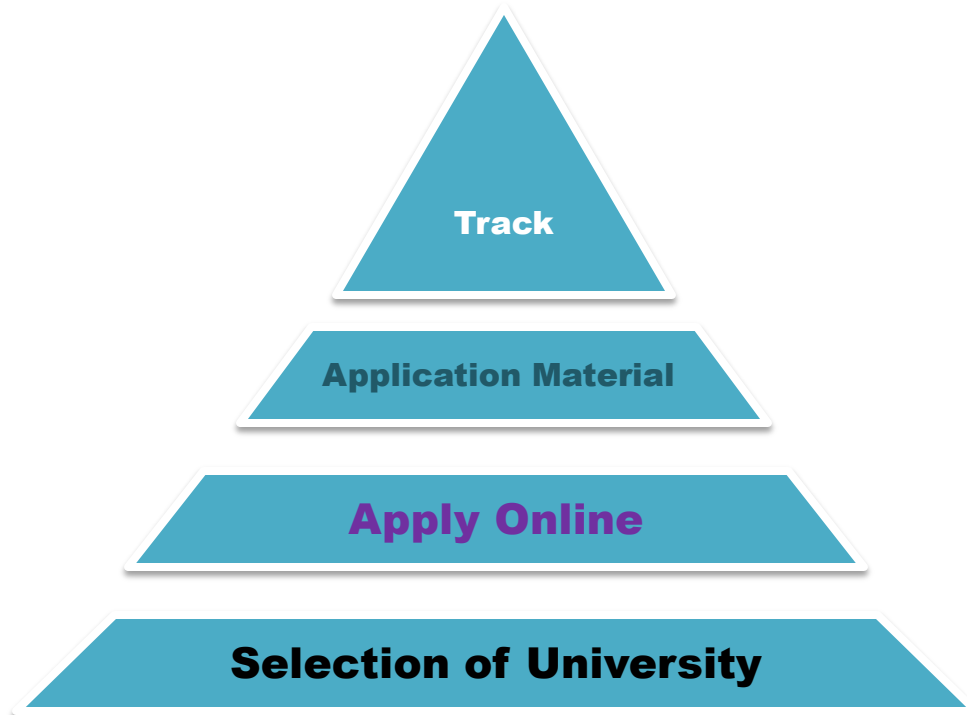

  - **Original Scanned Copies of All Academic Certificates, recommendations, SOP & Resume**

  - **Admit rate of University**
- **Advice on the selection of Major & specialization**
- **University Selection can also affect your VISA**

# Online Application Filling

# Application Material

- **Assist students in Building**

# Score Reporting

# Admissions Summary

- **Have realistic targets and work towards them**
  - IELTS or TOEFL Score
  - Selection of University & program
- **Don't look for shortcuts in application process**
- **Doing application process on your own gives you confidence for financial assistantship and VISA**
- **Planning & decision making is required at every stage of application process**

# VISA Decision, 5 Key Areas

1	<b>Profile</b>	Academic Background IELTS / TOEFL
2	<b>University</b>	Why this University? Knowledge of University
3	<b>Program</b>	Program Scope/Application of Major
4	<b>Sponsor</b>	Primary Sponsor's Income i.e. ITR'S, Funds in the form of FDR / Savings / Educational Loan
5	<b>Tuition Fee</b>	Receipt of Tuition Fee paid to University along with transaction statement of funds transfer from India to University in Ireland

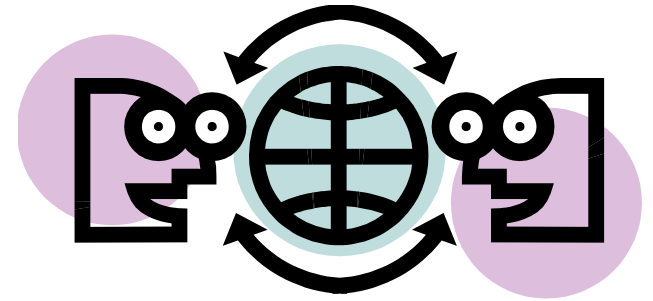
- **Economy, Recession**

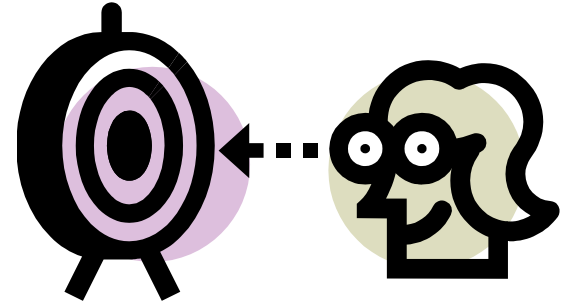

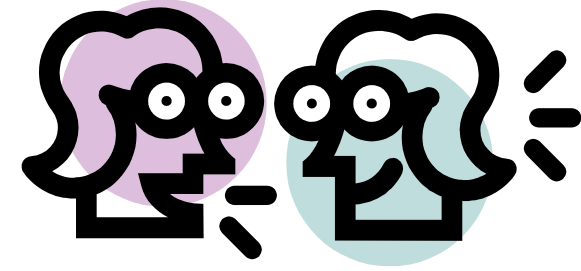

- Masters by Research – 2-years

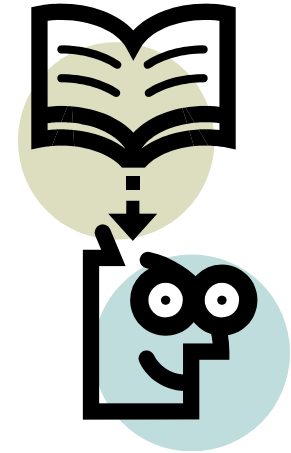
# Taught

# Research

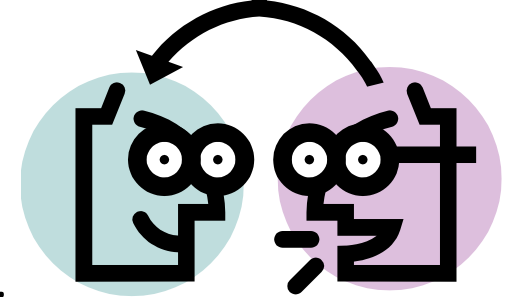
- Identify your interests
